





WALTHERS 'FAVORITE PROTOTYPE' SERIES


FP1-0 PRR 60' arch roof baggage




FP2-0 Pullman 6 cmpt 3dbl BR sleeper




FP3-0 NY Central 80' 36 seat diner




FP5-0 Santa Fe 75' high window coach, 3345 series*



FP7-H NY Central 75' four-door Bagg/Coach (HO only)



SANTA FE FEATURES


- OUTRIGGER UNDERFRAME. Santa Fe steel cars all feature the distinctive channel underframe section visible beneath the side.
- RIVET ARRANGEMENTS. These cars do NOT have belt rails. Instead, most have an extra row of rivets beneath the windows.
- LARGE WINDOWS. Most cars feature the "low" wide Santa Fe window typical of cars built or rebuilt for use in streamlined consists.
- * NEW PARTS. New roof and underbody details, as appropriate, have been included in these kits.



- BODY STYLES and window arrangements are different from other cars we have produced, so that the average builder may now include a wider variety of cars -- Smokers, Lounges, and Parlor cars, for example -- in his consists, while at the same time choosing from several styles of Head End, Coach, Diner, and Observation designs.
- MIX WELL. The Santa Fe prototypes may be lettered for other roads and will mix well with any of our 7800 line of passenger equipment.

COACH MODIFICATIONS

The 9156 Coach (Santa Fe series 3030-3067) can be fitted with louvres to model the 1100 series cars, or turned into a Snack Car (Santa Fe 3365-66). Instructions are included with the 9156 kit.
